Stage 2 of the Community Garden

As part of the Lawrence Hargrave Reserve upgrade, the City of Sydney (Council) will extend and significantly improve our community garden. At the moment we can expect this next stage to commence early March and aim to finish in August. We expect quite some construction during the upgrade, but access to the garden will be granted at all times.
